Request for Time Extension for Comments to OMB**

Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company operates an extensive interstate natural gas transmission system, of which 1383 miles are offshore. This pipeline system receives natural gas from the major production areas of the Gulf Coast for transportation and sale in the eastern United States. The operation of this pipeline system is subject to the requirements of Title 49 Code of Federal Regulation Parts 190, 191, 192, 193, and 199 and Title 30 Code of Federal Regulations Part 250, Subpart J, regarding Pipeline Rights-of-Way

Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company (TGP) is preparing comments per the notice at Volume 72, No. 191 FR 56442. TGP believes that this Rulemaking is significant and that the Administrative Burden has been underestimated, but it will take longer than the November 2, 2007, deadline to prepare complete comments. TGP therefore requests the deadline for comments to the federal Office of Management and Budget be extended from November 2, 2007, to the same as that for the rule comments to DOI, January 31, 2008.
