

### **Rejane “Johnnie” Burton**

Ms. Burton was appointed Director of the Minerals Management Service on March 15, 2002.

Ms. Burton served as Director of the Wyoming Department of Revenue from 1995 through February, 2002. Prior to that, she was vice president of Dwights Energydata, Inc, an information company specializing in oil and gas databases. Ms. Burton was also president and founder of Hotline Energy Reports, Inc. From 1982 through 1988, Ms. Burton was a member of the Wyoming State House of Representatives. She served as director of the First Wyoming Bank in Casper from 1981 through 1984.

Her career highlights also include positions as a lecturer and teacher of French at the university and high school levels and as a translator and interpreter for the Kansas City firm of J.F. Pritchard Company in Paris, France. Ms. Burton is a member of the National Order of Women Legislators and the American Association of Translators.

Born in French Algeria, Ms. Burton moved to the United States in 1963 and became an American citizen in 1968. She attended the Universities of Algiers and Paris, France, the University of Wyoming and the University of Arkansas. She holds two master's degrees and completed management training at Duke University.

Ms. Burton's late husband, Guy Burton, was a geologist and wildcatter in the Rocky Mountain West. She has two grown children.
