Nancy received her Ph.D. in zoology from the University of Texas at Austin in 1983. She is currently a Professor at the Louisiana Universities Marine Consortium. Her research interests include hypoxia, eutrophication, estuarine and benthic ecology, and continental shelf ecosystems. Her research and public outreach efforts in the realm of nutrient overenrichment and Gulf of Mexico hypoxia garnered a 1999 NOAA Environmental Hero Award, the 1999 Blasker Award for Science and Engineering, shared with Gene Turner of Louisiana State University, and the 12th Bostwick H. Ketchum Award from the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution. In addition, Dr. Rabalais is an AAAS Fellow, and Aldo Leopold Leadership Fellow, a Past President of the Estuarine Research Federation and the current Chair of the Ocean Studies Board.
